

# **PILEDRIVERS APPRENTICESHIP**

## **REGIONS 1 - 10**

The occupation of **Piledriver** will be taught under Standards administered by the **Oregon-SW Washington Carpenters Joint Apprenticeship Training Committee, MA # 1057**

The Apprentice in the **Piledriver** Apprenticeship Program will develop skills, knowledge and experience in many areas. Work Processes and Related Training include, but are not limited to, tools and materials, transit and level, maintenance and care of outboard motors, pumps and light plants. Framework for foundations and footings, concrete form construction, bridge construction and basic timber work. Oxygen-acetylene cutting, welding and arc welding. Pile driving equipment, cofferdams, sheet piling, driving of piles and drilling of piles. Rigging and signaling. Diving and tending (optional).

Travel **may be expected** throughout the State of Oregon and SW Washington.

Oregon - SW Washington Carpenters Joint Apprenticeship Training Committee wants you to know: We believe in Equal Employment Opportunity – The recruitment, selection, employment and training of apprentices shall be without discrimination.

Veterans who have GI Benefits may use them in this program. Under certain circumstances veterans may be granted direct entry to the program.

### **GEOGRAPHICAL AREA**

Regions 1-10 - The geographic areas covered by these standards shall be all counties in the State of Oregon. These standards shall also cover: Klickitat, Skamania, Clark, Cowlitz, Wahkiakum, Lewis, that portion of Pacific County south of a straight line made by extending the north boundary of Wahkiakum County west to the Pacific Ocean. This will include the entire peninsula west of Willapa bay in the State of Washington under the terms and conditions of the reciprocal agreement.

### **OPENING DATES AND TIMES**

Applications for the Piledrivers are **ONLY** accepted on the following listed dates & times:

The following dates **ONLY** between 9am and 10am

July 12, 13, 14, 15 and 16, 2010

**Minimum qualifications** for applicants are: Seventeen (17) years of age and have a high school diploma, GED or equivalent OR Eighteen (18) years of age.

**Selection Process** will be through “ranked interview” of qualified applicants. All applicants will be mailed the results of the ranking.

### **Who May Apply?**

Only the individual seeking admission to the program may apply. Applicants must apply in person.
